## Coach's Code of Conduct

## I will:

- 1. Be responsible for my own behavior and also the behavior of team members, their parents, and fans.
- Lead by example in being respectful of other players, coaches, fans, and officials at all times.
- 3. Provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and abusive language at all AHSA events.
- 4. Place the emotional and physical well being of all players ahead of a personal desire or external pressure to win.
- 5. Never publicly demean a player, official, opposing coach, or parent.
- 6. Ensure that my players are supervised by a head or assistant coach at all practices and games.
- Never conduct a practice without two adults present. One must be either the coach or an assistant coach (background checked) and the other may be a parent helper or observer.
- 8. Never allow a parent or other adult who is not a member of AHSA or has not undergone a background check to participate with players in a practice.
- 9. Never knowingly require an injured player to play or return to the game.
- 10. Take reasonable steps to see that all equipment used by my players is safe and conforms to standards.
- 11. Take the initiative in resolving any known or suspected conflict relating to a player or family.
- 12. Accept positive and negative feedback graciously as from the Lord.
- 13. Communicate expectations clearly to players and parents.
